



Medical Office Visit & Procedure Fees Orange County Migraine & Headache Center

1. Established 30 minute visit	\$250
2. Return Patient 45 minute extended	\$400
3. New Patient 45 minute visit	\$600
4. Botox Injection Procedure	\$600
5. Botox 155 units (200 unit Vial)	\$1300
6. Occipital nerve block	\$250 +
7. Trigger Point Injections	\$200 +
8. Phone Visits (Established 30 minute)	\$250
9. Office Visits outside of office hours	\$400
10. B-complex or B-12 shots	\$50 (billed out with \$25 injection fee; \$25 med.)
11. Toradol or Kenalog shots	\$50 (billed out with \$25 injection fee; \$25 med.)

If a patient has not been seen in > 1 year and wants to come back in to the office they should be given 45 minutes and will be charged \$400. After 1 year of not being seen, patients are considered inactive.

Filling out forms, i.e. disability is best done as part of an office visit. If done outside of an office visit there will be a minimum \$50 charge. This also applies to requests for letters to be written.

Prior authorizations will be done as a courtesy unless the initial request is denied. If a request is denied and a patient wants us to appeal and write a letter to the insurance company, then there will be a \$100 charge.

No show fee is \$75 and will be charged the 2nd time and all subsequent times a patient fails to show up for their appointment and does not call 24 hours prior to their appointment time.
